

Introduced by Buffalo Council Bill No. R 52-26

**A RESOLUTION**

authorizing a special event operations agreement with FPC Live, LLC for two (2) outdoor concert events inclusive of temporary street, alleyway, and parking lane closures, and temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet; setting forth a condition for approval.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to execute a special event operations agreement with FPC Live, LLC for two (2) outdoor concert events, substantially as set forth in "Attachment A" attached hereto and made a part hereof. The special event operations agreement shall be inclusive of the following:

1. Temporary street, alleyway, and parking lane closures, as identified in "Exhibit B" within the special event operations agreement, as follows:

**April 17, 2026**

- Closure of Ninth Street from Walnut Street to Broadway;
- Closure of the east-west alleyway north of Broadway and between Eighth Street and Ninth Street; and
- Closure of the parking lanes along both sides of Ninth Street from Walnut Street to Broadway.

**May 8, 2026**

- Closure of Ninth Street from Walnut Street to Broadway;
- Closure of the east-west alleyway north of Broadway and between Eighth Street and Ninth Street; and
- Closure of the parking lanes along both sides of Ninth Street from Walnut Street to Broadway.

2. Temporary waivers from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, for those days, times, and areas as identified in "Exhibit A" within the special event operations agreement.

SECTION 2. As a condition of approval, FPC Live, LLC shall comply with all requirements set forth in the special event operations agreement and by the Special Events Committee, including but not limited to, use of barricades compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic control Devices, and procurement of required liquor licenses and liability insurance.
