Re: Amending Chapter 14 of the City Code related to Parking Fees for Unmetered Off-Street Facilities

Executive Summary

Amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to allow the yearly permit rate for any municipal parking lot to be discounted by 5% when purchased in groups of five or more by an individual, business or agency.

Discussion

Section 14-393(d) of the City Code states that the yearly permit rate for any municipal parking structure will be discounted by 5% when purchased in groups of five or more by any one individual, business or agency. Given the recent increase in surface lot permit requests, the Parking Utility recommends passing the same 5% discount to surface lot permit holders. There is not a difference in maintenance/staffing requirements for surface lot permit management, versus municipal parking structure permit management. The exclusion of the discount for surface lot permits was most likely an oversight in the current ordinance.
