AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 27 of the City Code relating to the metering of electricity for residential dwelling units; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 27 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 27-111. Electricity—Metering of residential dwelling units.

Each residential dwelling unit must have a separate meter through which the electricity supplied the residential dwelling unit shall be measured for billing by the department. Metering of electricity supplying more than one residential dwelling unit through a single meter for billing by the department (master metering) is prohibited; except upon approval by the city council for good cause shown in planned zoning districts, where in the sole discretion of the director, master metering is in the best interests of the city due to the utilization by the planned development of alternative power sources which are incompatible with single metering.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
