**AN ORDINANCE**

amending Ordinance No. 023721 to rename the Molly Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center to the “Molly Thomas-Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center”; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 023721, passed on December 3, 2018, authorized the naming of the proposed facility to be constructed on an 8.54 acre tract located on the south side of International Drive and approximately 300 feet east of Rangeline Street as the “Molly Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center”; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the City Council, with the consent of the family of Molly Bowden, to include the maiden name of Molly Bowden on such facility such that it will be known as the “Molly Thomas-Bowden Neighborhood Policing Center.”

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Section 1. of Ordinance No. 023721 is amended as follows:
