Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a subrecipient award from the State Emergency Management Agency for the MRC-STTRONG project in the amount of \$62,167.05.

Discussion

The Missouri State Emergency Management Agency wishes to enter into a subrecipient agreement with the City of Columbia in the amount of \$62,167.05 for the Medical Reserve Corps. The purpose of the Missouri Medical Reserve Corps (MRC) Program is to support ongoing preparedness initiatives as well as recruit, train, and activate medical and public health professionals and other volunteers to respond to community health needs during disasters and other public health emergencies. This funding will be used to: 1) Strengthen the capacity of existing MRCs, 2) Increase the public health and related emergency management workforce, 3) Promote greater awareness of MRCs and their value to the community. This year's award (\$62,167.05) is a slight increase from the prior year (\$58,257.64)
