A RESOLUTION

expressing support for renovation of the Columbia Housing Authority's Bryant Walkway Apartments and associated application to the Missouri Housing Development Commission for low income housing tax credits; authorizing letters of support.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest and general welfare of the City that affordable rental housing that is accessible, energy efficient, healthy, safe and well-maintained be made available to the residents of the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, Missouri will submit to the Missouri Housing Development Commission an application for consideration of award of Low Income Housing Tax Credits necessary to finance the renovation of the Bryant Walkway Apartments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Columbia hereby supports the application made by the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, Missouri to the Missouri Housing Development Commission for nine percent (9%) Low Income Housing Tax Credits for renovation of seventy (70) public housing units known as the Bryant Walkway Apartments.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes Mayor Treece and Council member Ruffin to provide letters of support to the Housing Authority of the City of Columbia, Missouri for the Bryant Walkway Apartments renovation project.
