Re: Appointment of Advisory Board for the Columbia Arts Fund

Executive Summary

In 2012, the City Council approved the establishment of the Columbia Arts Fund with the Community Foundation of Central Missouri. This memo seeks to re-establish the advisory committee and members for the fund.

Discussion

The establishing document for the Columbia Arts Fund, drawn up through collaboration between the City of Columbia and the Community Foundation of Central Missouri, calls for the fund to have an advisory committee as described: "An Advisory Committee shall consist of the chair of the City's Commission on Cultural Affairs, three members of the Commission appointed by the City Council and the Manager of the Office of Cultural Affairs. The Commission Chair shall serve as the Chair of the Advisory Committee." There has been a lapse in sustaining advisory committee members, and the OCA seeks to re-establish this committee.

At its March 11, 2019 Commission on Cultural Affairs meeting, the following persons are recommended to Council to serve as members of the Advisory Committee of the Columbia Arts Fund: James Melton (member), Natalie Thomas (member), Alan Toigo (member), Lili Vianello (Chair of the Commission), and Sarah Dresser (Manager of the Office of Cultural Affairs). While there is no formal rotation schedule for members, replacement members of the Advisory Committee will be submitted for approval periodically as Commission members rotate off and on. Upon Council approval, these names and contact information will be registered with the Community Foundation and they will have the authority to provide guidance to the Columbia Arts Fund.
