Re: Authorizing a special event operations agreement with Ragtag Film Society, for the execution of the 2019 True False Film Festival.

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an operations agreement for the 2019 True False Film Festival being held at various venues in downtown Columbia. The True/False Film Festival will be held February 28 through March 3, 2019, from 9 a.m. until 1 a.m. daily for its sixteenth edition.

## Discussion

The Operations Agreement addresses the following items:

- Go CoMo operation during the festival
- Film venues/festival layout plan
- Temporary art installations at various downtown locations
- Parade route and street closure for the March March parade and Jubilee
- City Sponsorship agreement - \$12,000
- Liability insurance requirements
- City trash and recycling services

There are no notable changes from the 2018 event. The City Event Committee has met with festival organizers and recommends approval of the operations agreement.
