Re: Subgrantee Agreement Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture

## Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a subgrantee agreement between Columbia Center for Urban Agriculture and the City of Columbia, MO for a four year period beginning at the date of execution.

## Discussion

The City received a grant from the Missouri Foundation for Health to support the work of the Food Council. CCUA would serve as a subgrantee to this grant. The purpose of this funding is to support Food Council (FC)'s work to create a resilient, equitable, and sustainable local food system that positively impacts the nutritional, economic, social, environmental, and human health of the City of Columbia (BC). CCUA would support this work though assisting with the development and implementation of the Community Food System Assessment, assist in data collection, and assist with the administration of a mini-grant program. The total amount that will be provided to CCUA over the 4 year period is \$176,000.
