Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a Program Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Crisis Cooperative Agreement. The agreement period is March 16, 2021 through March 15, 2022 and the amount will not exceed \$255,529.00.

This purpose of this agreement is to demonstrate measurable and sustainable progress toward achieving public health and healthcare preparedness capabilities and promote prepared and resilient communities. These funds will be used to contribute to the response to COVID-19 for local public health and healthcare preparedness related to surveillance, epidemiology, laboratory capacity, infection control, mitigation, communications, and other preparedness response activities associated with COVID-19 response activities.
