

A RESOLUTION

directing the City Manager to proceed with the development of a capital improvement project list to be funded by the proposed extension of the one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax for a period of ten (10) years.

WHEREAS, in preparation for the proposed extension of the local parks sales tax, the City contracted with ETC Institute to establish priorities for the future improvement of parks and recreation facilities and services within the community; and

WHEREAS, the current one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax was approved by the voters with a sunset of six (6) years; and

WHEREAS, City staff is in the process of developing a proposed capital improvement project list to be funded by a renewal of the one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax and has requested guidance from City Council on the timeframe for such renewal in order to more accurately develop such list of projects; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide guidance to the City Manager by stating its intent to consider a ten (10) year extension of the one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax for purposes of developing a capital improvement project list to be funded by such local parks sales tax extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby directs the City Manager to proceed with the development of a ten (10) year capital improvement project list to be funded by a proposed extension of the one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax.
