Re: Amending Chapter 21 of the City Code to Provide for Extensions of Time by the Police Chief to Allow for Sufficient Time for the Filing of an Appeal

Executive Summary

An ordinance has been prepared to amend Chapter 21 of the City Code to allow the police chief to provide for extensions to allow sufficient time for the conduct of an investigation as well as sufficient time for the filing and review of an appeal to the Citizens Police Review Board (CPRB) and/or City Manager.

Discussion

On February 21, 2022, the CPRB sent a report to the City Council requesting an amendment to the City Code to require the police chief to request an extension of time under Sec. 590.502 RSMo. to ensure there is adequate time for the CPRB and City Manager to perform a review of a complaint. On a vote of 4 to 2, the Council voted for it to come back as an ordinance. The proposed ordinance to amend Chapter 21 would accomplish the stated goals of the CPRB's request.
