Re: University of Missouri Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital Agreement

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between the City of Columbia and the Curators of the University of Missouri on behalf of its Veterinary Medical Teaching Hospital for emergency veterinary services in an amount not to exceed \$7,000. The agreement period is October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019.

## Discussion

This agreement allows for after-hours emergency veterinary medical services to care for injured animals retrieved by animal control officers.
