

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 112-19

A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of the sidewalk and parking lane on the east side of Waugh Street, between Paquin Street and Locust Street, to facilitate the removal and replacement of a retaining wall adjacent to Locust Street Elementary School.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the Columbia Public School District to close a portion of the sidewalk and parking lane on the east side of Waugh Street, between Paquin Street and Locust Street, from August 6, 2019 to October 8, 2019 to facilitate the removal and replacement of a retaining wall adjacent to Locust Street Elementary School.

SECTION 2. The Columbia Public School District shall close the sidewalk and parking lane only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying the Columbia Public School District, in writing, of such requirements. The Columbia Public School District shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the sidewalk and parking lane due to any damage caused by the construction activity. The Columbia Public School District shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The Columbia Public School District shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary sidewalk and parking lane closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary closures authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such closures are no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.
