Re: Downtown CID Board of Directors – Membership Changes due to Vacancies

Impacted Ward: Ward 1

Executive Summary

The Downtown Community Improvement District (CID) Board of Directors has submitted a slate of proposed Board of Director members to the Mayor for consideration for appointment.

Discussion

The Downtown CID was established by ordinance on February 7, 2011, and it provided for fifteen Board of Directors members. The initial fifteen members were appointed by the ordinance establishing the Downtown CID to staggering terms of one, two, and three years.

Current Board of Director members are:

Aric Jarvis (Term ending February 6, 2027)

Jamie Varvaro (Term ending February 6, 2027)

Tanner Ott (Term ending February 6, 2027)

Kathleen Murphy (Term ending February 6, 2027)

Vacant - was previously Kenny Greene (Term ending February 6, 2027)

Russell Boyt (Term ending February 6, 2028)

Vacant – was previously Mary Stauffer (Term ending February 6, 2028)

Zach Wagner (Term ending February 6, 2028)

Mike Nolan (Term ending February 6, 2028)

Tootie Burns (Term ending February 6, 2028)

Nick McKague (Term ending February 6, 2029)

Colleen Rieman (Term ending February 6, 2029)

The qualifications to serve on the Board of Directors are set out in the Downtown CID petition and state law. It is required that each director be at least 18 years of age and be either an owner of real property within the District, an owner of a business operating within the District, or a registered voter residing in the District, all as defined in the CID Act (Section 67.1401 RSMo. et seq.).

The petition governing the formation of the Downtown CID provides the appointment process of members to the Board of Directors. Upon submission of a slate of successor

directors by the Downtown CID to the Mayor, the Mayor (with the consent of the City Council) shall approve the appointments or request alternates be submitted by the Downtown CID Board of Directors. The approval or request for alternates is required to occur within 30 days of submission of names by the Downtown CID.

If there is a request for alternative names, the Downtown CID Board of Directors shall resubmit the slate with alternates, and the Mayor shall choose appointees from the names submitted and seek the consent of the City Council. The City Council can accept or refuse consent of the slate submitted by the Mayor. If the City Council refuses to consent to the slate, within ten days, the Mayor shall request alternatives from the Downtown CID Board of Directors.

The Downtown CID submitted a slate on April 15, 2026 that included Glyn Laverick and Justin Riley. The recommendation by the Downtown CID is to appoint Glyn Laverick to the term previously held by Kenny Greene ending on February 6, 2027 and to appoint Justin Riley to the term previously held by Mary Stauffer ending on February 6, 2028.
