Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Contract Amendment 01 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021.

Discussion

The Public Health Emergency Preparedness contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services provides annual funding for public health emergency preparedness. This contract is amended to add an additional \$35,148 for expenses associated with COVID-19 response.
