A RESOLUTION

granting Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet for the area along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street, on October 31, 2025 and November 1, 2025 for outdoor events.

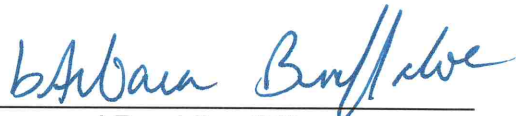
BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby grants Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. a temporary waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code so that the possession of an open container of alcohol and consumption of an alcoholic beverage, and Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified sound exceeding a distance of 300 feet, shall be allowed from 5:00 p.m. until 1:30 a.m. the following day for the area along a portion of the alleyway located north of Locust Street and between Sixth Street and Seventh Street adjacent to 119 S. Seventh Street, for outdoor events on October 31, 2025 and November 1, 2025. As a condition of approval, Radar Hospitality Company, L.L.C. shall comply with all requirements set forth by the Special Events Committee, including but not limited to, use of barricades compliant with the Manual on Uniform Traffic control Devices and procurement of required liquor licenses and liability insurance.
