Re: Sidewalk Renovation Agreement with First Presbyterian Church for reconstruction of

sidewalk along 16 Hitt Street, Administrative Public Improvement process

Executive Summary

Authorizing the City Manager to execute a Sidewalk Renovation Agreement with First Presbyterian Church for reconstruction of the sidewalk along 16 Hitt Street. This request falls under the Sidewalk Maintenance and Construction policy approved by Council on November 6, 2023, per Ordinance 025490. The project will follow the administrative public improvement process, unless Council prefers to follow the standard public improvement process

Discussion

First Presbyterian Church has requested assistance from the City to share the cost of repairing the sidewalk along 16 Hitt Street at the intersection with Cherry Street. The sidewalk is adjacent to the church property. The sidewalk improvements will include removing and reconstructing existing sidewalk panels and curb ramp in order to improve Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) accessibility.

The Church has obtained three bids to complete the improvements. The bid from Concrete Concepts was the low bid to complete the sidewalk replacement work for \$4,950.00. Once the sidewalk work is complete, the City will reimburse First Presbyterian Church 50% of the cost to repair the sidewalk with a not to exceed amount of \$2,475.00. Construction is planned for late summer of 2025. The project will follow the administrative public improvement process, unless directed by Council to follow the standard public improvement process

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The City's contribution to the cost share is a not to exceed amount of \$2,475.00. It will be funded with the $\frac{1}{4}$ -cent Capital Improvement Program sales tax. Long-Term Impact: None
