Council Bill No. B 224-17

AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code as it relates to parking fees; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended by repealing Section 14-393 and adopting in lieu thereof a new Section 14-393 to read as follows:

Sec. 14-393. Parking fees for unmetered off-street facilities.

(a) Except as otherwise provided herein, the rates for a parking permit to park a single vehicle in an unmetered parking space designated for permit parking in the following municipal parking structures:

Eighth Street and Cherry Street Garage, and
Eighth Street and Walnut Street Plaza Garage

for a non-reserved parking space permit shall be:

\$95.00 per month,
\$280.00 per quarter, or
\$1,045.00 per year; and

for a reserved parking space permit shall be:

\$135.00 per month.

(b) Except as otherwise provided herein, the rates for a parking permit to park a single vehicle in an unmetered parking space designated for permit parking in the following municipal parking structures:

Tenth Street and Cherry Street Garage,
Sixth Street and Cherry Street Garage,
Fifth Street and Walnut Street Garage, and
Short Street Garage

for a non-reserved parking space permit shall be:

\$75.00 per month,
\$220.00 per quarter, or
\$825.00 per year; and

for a reserved parking space permit shall be:

\$115.00 per month.

(c) Except as otherwise provided herein, the rates for a parking permit to park a single vehicle in a reserved or non-reserved unmetered parking space designated for permit parking in the following municipal surface parking lots:

Armory Parking Lot,
Ninth Street and Ash Street Parking Lot (a/k/a Municipal Lot No. 7), and
Wabash Parking Lot

shall be:

\$70.00 per month,
\$205.00 per quarter, or
\$770.00 per year.

(f) The yearly permit rate for any municipal parking structure will be discounted by five (5) percent when purchased in groups of five (5) or more by any one (1) individual, business or agency.

(g) A fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be imposed for replacement or non-return of each radio frequency identification (RFID) hangtag which is issued to a holder of a non-reserved or reserved parking permit

(h) All persons, including city employees, who have purchased a parking permit in an unmetered off-street facility will be provided an unlimited use bus pass for no additional charge.

(i) No person shall park in a reserved or non-reserved permit parking space without a hangtag or sticker appropriately affixed to the vehicle. Members of the police department and any other agents of the city assigned to traffic duty or parking enforcement are hereby authorized to remove or cause to be removed at the owner's expense any vehicle found parked or maintained in violation of these provisions.

(j) The city manager may authorize the use of hard-surfaced, city-owned property for temporary public parking lots. Parking spaces on temporary public parking lots shall be rented only on a monthly basis at the rate of sixty-five dollars (\$65.00) per month.

(k) The director of public works may issue special daily parking permits for unmetered off-street parking facilities to licensed businesses that need additional parking for their customers or guests. The director is authorized to make rules governing the issuance and revocation of such permits. The fee for these special daily parking permits shall be seventy-five (75) percent of the parking meter hood daily rate under section 14-424(a)(1). If a business obtains more than twenty (20) permits for a single day, an additional discount of five (5) percent for each additional ten (10) permits shall apply up to a maximum discount of fifty (50) percent of the parking meter hood daily rate under section 14-424(a)(1).

(l) Whenever it is determined by the city manager that the city or its parking utility would benefit from the long-term lease of certain parking spaces, the city manager is authorized to enter into negotiations to lease between five (5) and thirty (30) off-street parking spaces to any particular lessee under terms and conditions that the city manager deems advisable provided that:

- (1) The annual rate per leased parking space is equal to the rate charged for parking spaces located on the upper-most uncovered floors of existing city parking garages no matter where the leased space is located; provided that, if covered space is leased, the annual rate per leased parking space shall be the rate charged for covered floors of existing city parking garages. No discount shall be given for leasing five (5) or more spaces.
- (2) The city retains the right to change the location of the leased spaces at any time dependent upon the needs of the city; however, if the city determines it is necessary to move the leased spaces to another city lot, the lessee shall have the right to terminate the lease effective as of the date of relocation.

All leases of long-term parking spaces shall be approved by the city council prior to becoming effective.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after October 1, 2017.
