Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Healthy Families America program in the amount of \$88,007 for the period of October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2018

Discussion

This is a contract for the Healthy Families America program, an evidence-based community home visitation model serving at-risk pregnant women and families with young children. The goals of the program are to build and sustain community partnerships to systematically engage overburdened families in home visiting services; cultivate and strengthen nurturing parent child relationships; promote healthy childhood growth and development; and enhance family functioning by reducing risk and building protective factors. Authorization to enter this agreement will allow the program to operate at its current capacity.
