Re: Discovery Park Subdivision Plat 4 PD Plan - Major Plan Amendment (Case #182-2021)

### **Executive Summary**

Approval of this request will amend an existing PD plan to add a pickleball court amenity for residents.

#### Discussion

Anderson Engineering (agent), on behalf of Discovery Park Apartments, LLC (owner), is seeking approval of a PD Plan (Planned Development) amendment to the *Discovery Park Subdivision Plat 4 PD Plan*, most recently revised on July 20, 2020, that proposes to add pickleball courts as an amenity to the site. The 12.92-acre property is located on the west side of Nocona Parkway, approximately 1,500 feet south of Ponderosa Street.

The Planning and Zoning Commission considered this request at their June 24, 2021 meeting. Staff presented its report and the applicant gave an overview of the request. No member of the public spoke during the public hearing. Following limited discussion, a motion to approve the PD plan amendment passed (7-0-1) with one recusal.
