

Introduced by Treese Council Bill No. R 151-20

**A RESOLUTION**

authorizing staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Lakeshore Drive and Edgewood Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #23); directing that a public hearing be held upon completion of the preliminary plans.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2010 and April 19, 2010, the City Clerk received petitions for the formation of a private common collector elimination (PCCE) project from certain property owners on Lakeshore Drive, Edgewood Avenue and Glenwood Avenue; and

WHEREAS, City's Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division identified the private common collector sewer main that serves the Lakeshore Drive and Edgewood Avenue area to be in poor structural condition; and

WHEREAS, the preliminary estimated cost of the proposed Lakeshore Drive and Edgewood Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #23) is \$225,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes and directs staff to proceed with the preliminary design and expenditure of funds associated with the proposed construction of the Lakeshore Drive and Edgewood Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #23).

SECTION 2. Upon completion of the preliminary plans for the proposed Lakeshore Drive and Edgewood Avenue Private Common Collector Elimination Project (PCCE #23), the City Council further directs that a public hearing be held in respect to this improvement.


