Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Environmental Child Care Sanitation Inspections Participation Agreement

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Environmental Child Care Sanitation Inspections Participation Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the period of October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2019.

Discussion

The State of Missouri provides funding to local health departments to provide sanitation inspections of child care facilities. Reimbursement rates are \$120 per annual licensing inspection and \$70 per re-inspection, \$30 per hour for special circumstance inspections and \$25 for attempted inspections on facilities that are closed.
