**A RESOLUTION**

adopting an implementation plan for the expenditure of local parks sales tax revenue.

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia is authorized by Section 644.032 RSMo to impose a sales tax for the purpose of funding local parks, subject to voter approval; and

WHEREAS, a majority of the qualified voters of the City of Columbia voting thereon at an election duly held on November 2, 2021, approved a one-eighth of one percent local parks sales tax for a period of ten (10) years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia intends to use this sales tax to fund land acquisition for parks, greenways and natural areas, maintenance improvements to existing parks and facilities, annual funding for equipment replacement and program scholarships, new facility and park development, land acquisition for trails and greenbelts and capital improvement projects for such, and contingency purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council adopts the implementation plan for the expenditure of local parks sales tax revenue as set forth in "Exhibit A" attached hereto and made a part hereof.
