Re: CARES Act Funding Agreement with Boone County

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the CARES Act Funding Agreement between the City of Columbia and Boone County. The contract amount shall not exceed \$1,799,004.64 for the period of August 1, 2020 through December 30, 2020.

Discussion

This agreement provides CARES Act funding from Boone County to Public Health and Human Services. This funding will be used to hire temporary staff to assist with disease investigations, contact tracing, communicable disease investigation, data entry and analysis, and community health education. In addition, funding will be used to provide COVID 19 testing for uninsured individuals in Boone County. According to federal guidance, the funding needs to be expended by December 30, 2020.
