


2025 CAAP Update

- **Not changing** Community or Municipal GHG reduction goals.
- **Not changing** the structure of the plan (Sector, Strategy, Action).



Vulnerability Assessment

- Cascadia updated the 2019 Climate Vulnerability Analysis.
- Cascadia created an online GIS map tool to help visualize the climate hazards for both key infrastructure and people.



Progress Report

- Cascadia reviewed the City's progress and provided recommendations for future actions.
- Cascadia staff used input collected from staff to organize existing actions into 4 categories:
 - 5-year Plan
 - Ongoing
 - Longterm
 - Completed, Redundant, Remove



Interviews

- Cascadia and OS staff hosted 2 interviews with City staff and 2 interviews with stakeholder groups. Interviews were focused on areas staff felt needed more input before starting Focus Groups.
 - Departmental
 - Utilities, Finance, and Public Works
 - Public Health, Equity, and Office of Neighborhood Services
 - Stakeholders
 - Daniel Boone Regional Library, Home Health Provider Network (coordinated by Public Health)
 - Home Builder, Developer, Habitat for Humanity
 - Transit, Equity, and Local Motion


Focus Groups

- Cascadia and OS staff hosted 3 Focus Groups on 12/4 and 12/5. Participants provided feedback on draft actions with a focus on actions to be considered for the next 5 years.
 - Energy and Buildings
 - Utilities, Sierra Club, RAP, EIERA, Missouri Green Banc, NREL, Renew Missouri
 - Transportation and Development
 - Transit (GoCOMO), Community Development, Local Motion, MODOT, University of Missouri, REDI
 - Health, Waste, and Natural Resources
 - CCUA, Columbia Audubon Society, Boone County, MCC, ONS, ESS, Taylor's Commercial Grounds Maintenance, Solid Waste
