Re: Agreement with Columbia Mall, LLC to hold the 2019 Tons of Trucks event at the Columbia Mall parking lot.

Executive Summary

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting a resolution to authorize the City Manager to execute an agreement with Columbia Mall, LLC to hold the Tons of Trucks event at the Columbia Mall parking lot on May 1, 2019. There is no fee associated with the agreement.

Discussion

The Parks and Recreation Department has been hosting the Tons of Trucks event annually at the Columbia Mall parking lot since 2014. About 4,000 people attend the event. The 2019 event is scheduled on May 1. The agreement is substantially the same as in previous years. There is no fee associated with the agreement.

The agreement outlines the responsibilities of the organizer (City of Columbia) and the owner (Columbia Mall, LLC). Columbia Mall will rope off the area for the event; provide a mall sweeper truck; security officer and security vehicle; and tables, chairs and trash cans for food trucks. The Parks and Recreation Department will provide additional trash cans, the vehicles on display, event oversight, and marketing for the event that includes the mall logo or name.
