A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closure of a portion of Rollins Street, between Hitt Street and Virginia Avenue, to facilitate the repair and partial reconstruction of three deteriorated steam manholes.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the University of Missouri to temporarily close a portion of Rollins Street, between Hitt Street and Virginia Avenue, as shown on "Exhibit A," from May 15, 2017 to August 11, 2017 to facilitate the repair and partial reconstruction of three deteriorated steam manholes.

SECTION 2. The University of Missouri shall close the street only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying the University of Missouri, in writing, of such requirements. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair of the street due to any damage caused by the construction activity. The University of Missouri shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. The University of Missouri shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary street closure without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the street closure permit by the City Council.
