Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign an Information Exchange Agreement between Columbia Police Department (CPD) and Boone County Sheriff's Office (BCSO) for access to the Boone County Sheriff's Office Records Management System.
