Re: Agreements for the Purchase of Social Services

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign six (6) agreements for the purchase of social services, effective January 1, 2021 through December 31, 2021. The total contracted amount shall not exceed \$328,707.00 for the contract period.

Discussion

The Department of Public Health and Human Services administers the City of Columbia process for the purchase of social services. In July, 2020, a request for proposals was issued for social services to address issues related to opportunity. Based on the review and rating of the proposals, the Human Services Commission and staff have recommended the City establish six (6) new purchase of service agreements with six (6) organizations, for a total amount not to exceed \$328,707.00, as outlined in Exhibit A and conforming with the general form of the standard social services provider agreement (Exhibit B). Detailed information regarding the social services funding allocation process and the purchase of service contract recommendations are included in the attached City of Columbia FY2021 Social Services Funding Process and Contract Recommendations Report to the Columbia City Council (Attachment 1).
