Re: Budget Appropriation - Historic Preservation Commission

Executive Summary

Approval of this request will result in the appropriation of funds received from the November 5, 2017 Historic Preservation Commission Salvage Sale to the New Century Fund.

Discussion

As a means of fundraising and recycling a number of architecturally significant artifacts, the Historic Preservation Commission has created an architectural salvage program. Using leads generated from demolition permit applications submitted to the City's Community Development Department, the Commission contacts property owners to seek permission to enter the subject properties and remove architecturally and historically significant pieces from the home, including windows, mantles, flooring, doors, hardware, & etc. These items are then housed on City property until such time as public sales can be conducted.

In November 2017, the Historic Preservation Commission conducted its second such Architectural Salvage Sale at which \$1,014.00 in revenue was generated. Following the sale, the revenue was deposited into the City's Contributions Fund (480563), with the intention to transfer the funds into the New Century Fund (504990) for investment purposes and future use as a revolving loan fund for private historic preservation activities.

The Commission, at this time, requests that the funds generated by the sale be transferred from the City's Contributions Fund, to the Commission's account within the New Century Fund, to be held for the above stated purposes.
