Re: Central Missouri Community Action – Employment and Skills Training

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an amendment to an agreement between Central Missouri Community Action (CMCA) and the City of Columbia, MO.

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On February 20, 2024, the City Manager signed an agreement with CMCA for employment and skills training. This amendment includes a timeline created by the agency and reviewed by city staff. All other terms remain unchanged.
