

Introduced by McDavid Council Bill No. R 8-16

A RESOLUTION

declaring the necessity for construction of the Douglass Park – Phase II improvement project to include construction of shelters, replacement of playground equipment, construction of a skate spot, ADA walkway improvements, the installation of new signage and park lighting improvements; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the improvement; providing for payment for the improvement; providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law; and setting a public hearing.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council deems the construction of the Douglass Park – Phase II improvement project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City. Specific improvements include the following:

- Construction of a 48-foot by 28-foot shelter to replace an existing shelter.
- Installation of new ADA compliant playground equipment to replace existing equipment.
- Construction of a 15-foot by 15-foot prefab shelter located adjacent to the playground.
- Development and construction of a 4,500 square foot skate spot to be located at the southeast corner of the park adjacent to the Fifth Street parking area.
- Construction of ADA walkway improvements to improve connectivity between park amenities; installation of new bike racks; construction of new horseshoe pits; installation of new signage; and lighting improvements.

SECTION 2. The nature and scope of the improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$225,000.00.

SECTION 4. Payment for this improvement shall be made from parks sales tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 5. Any work done in connection with the construction of the improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.

SECTION 6. A public hearing in respect to this improvement will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on February 15, 2016. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.
