Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Healthy Eating Active Living in Local Communities Contract Amendment #03

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #03 to the Healthy Eating Active Living in Local Communities Contract #AOC15380128 between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services. Amendment #03 renews the current contract and shall not exceed \$50,000 for the period of October 1, 2016 through September 30, 2017.

Discussion

This contract allows Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to implement evidence-based approaches for local environmental and system changes to increase healthy eating and physical activity. The original contract included projects focusing on Missouri Live Well Restaurants, Missouri Move Smart Early Childhood Education facilities, adding a bus shelter, and improving community gardens in the project area. This is the third consecutive year for the funding.

The funding with this amendment supports three projects: Active Worksites, Stock Healthy Shop Healthy, and Missouri Live Well Restaurants. PHHS plans to partner with Columbia Public Schools and City of Columbia Employee Wellness to develop programs that promote employee physical activity. Stock Healthy Shop Healthy is a program developed by MU Extension to increase access to healthy foods. Finally, PHHS will expand the Missouri Live Well Restaurant Program to reach additional restaurants in the City of Columbia and Boone County.

Council's approval of this amendment enables further investment in public health and further implementation of the Community Health Improvement Plan.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: An appropriation is necessary. This grant funding was not anticipated during the FY17 budget process. There is no impact on the general fund.
