Re: Memorandum of Understanding for Emergency Vaccine/Medication Dispensing

Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the interim City Manager to sign an agreement between the City of Columbia and Columbia Public Schools for mass dispensing of medical supplies, as necessary. The MOU would remain in effect until June 30, 2022 and can be renewed for successive terms of one year.

Discussion

During an emergency event where community wide dispensing of medications, vaccines or medical supplies is needed, Columbia/Boone County Public Health and Human Services partners with large employers in the community to accept an allotted amount of medical material to dispense to their employees through standing orders. This agreement would allow Public Health and Human Services to provide medical material to Columbia Public Schools for dispensing to staff.
