Staff explained that an alignment through the Center Project was still possible. Center Project representatives were cautiously open to that idea. Interest was expressed in providing curb and gutter along the entire east side of the street. At the request of the neighborhood, Staff looked at the possibility of installing detention and or green infrastructure upstream to reduce flood flows, and, while agreed that it needs to be pursued, it is impractical to do so in a time-frame that helps this project.
