A RESOLUTION

authorizing application and acceptance of freight enhancement funds from the Missouri Department of Transportation for the tie and rail replacement project on the Columbia Terminal Railroad (COLT).

WHEREAS, the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission is authorized to make grants for freight enhancement projects; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Columbia, Missouri desires to enter into an agreement with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission for funds to aid in said City's project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes the City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, to file an application for funds with the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission and execute on behalf of the City of Columbia, Missouri any documents necessary thereto.

SECTION 2. That the present City Manager is De'Carlton Seewood and the City Manager's designee with respect to matters relating to the COLT Railroad is Director of Utilities David Sorrell. The City of Columbia will immediately notify the Missouri Highway and Transportation Commission of any changes in these positions or designation of authorized agents.

SECTION 3. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to expend funds for freight enhancement projects.

SECTION 4. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to submit request for reimbursement for freight enhancement projects.

SECTION 5. The City of Columbia, Missouri pledges and warrants to provide matching funds of not less than twenty percent (20%) of the capital funds granted to the City for freight enhancement projects, acknowledging that failure to do so will result in loss of such grant funds.
