Re: Rescinding Resolution No. 57-18 – Agreement with Burns & McDonnell for the Documented Categorical Exclusion (CATEX)

Executive Summary

Staff requests Council rescind Resolution 57-18 which authorized a professional engineering services agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. for the Documented Categorical Exclusion (CATEX).

Discussion

On April 16, 2018, Council adopted Resolution 57-18 authorizing a professional engineering services agreement with Burns & McDonnell Engineering, Inc. for the Documented Categorical Exclusion (CATEX) project. This is a checklist that is required by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) to justify support for development of the proposed terminal, related aprons, taxiways, access and service roads, parking lots, and associated development. After this Resolution was adopted, the Missouri Department of Transportation notified staff on May 18, 2018, that an RFP would be required. This RFP must be developed with the CATEX specifically listed to qualify for 90% reimbursement.

The rescinding of Resolution 57-18 will allow the Columbia Regional Airport to complete an RFP. The creation of a new RFP will allow the City of Columbia to be reimbursed 90% of the total project cost from the Missouri Department of Transportation.
