

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: The Sinclair Road/Southampton Road sidewalk gaps will include construction of a 5-foot wide concrete sidewalk to connect existing sidewalk with newly constructed sidewalk. On Sinclair Road, the gap is approximately 65 linear feet long along the backyard of 5109 Covington Court. This project will connect the sidewalk constructed with the subdivision development with the sidewalk constructed for the new middle school. On Southampton Road, the gap is approximately 35 linear feet long along the backyards of 1805 and 1807 Kenilworth Drive. This project will connect two sidewalks constructed by subdivision developments. The sidewalk will be constructed in existing street right-of-way, but temporary construction easements will be needed at the Southampton location. Staff will utilize a City term and supply contract to complete construction of the project. Construction is planned for this summer.
