

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Hitt Street Compactor Installation Project – This project involves replacing an existing 8-yard refuse dumpster with a 14-yard refuse compactor on City owned property. The project site is located on the west side of Hitt Street between Elm Street and Locust Street. The scope of work includes the installation of a new electric service, installation / repair of concrete pavement, installation of singage and the installation of a 14-yard refuse compactor.

Department: Utilities

Estimated cost: \$25,000

Funding source: Solid Waste Utility operational funds

Project meets the following criterion (check one):

- Construction, upgrade or relocation of electric distribution lines less than sixty-nine (69) KV that is estimated to cost less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
- Water and electric production facility expansion projects estimated to cost less than five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000.00).
- Sanitary sewer projects estimated to cost less than one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00).
- Storm water utility public improvement projects estimated to cost less than one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000.00).
- Any project estimated to cost less than fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00).

No tax bills will be issued for the project.

Project does not require exercise of power of eminent domain.


IP meeting held on: Oct 4, 2023. Input received on BeHeard.CoMo.gov through Oct 13, 2023


Attendance: Three individuals attended IP meeting.
