A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of the Quail Drive – Phase 2 stormwater improvement project; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of the Quail Drive – Phase 2 storm water improvement project was held by the City Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division on November 12, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on March 2, 2026. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed replacement of 70 feet of failed corrugated metal pipe and construction of approximately 180 feet of storm water pipe, one (1) inlet, a flume with three (3) inlets, and a junction box, as part of the Quail Drive – Phase 2 storm water improvement project, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement project shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$130,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement project shall be made from the Storm Water Utility Fund and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement project specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
