Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an Amendment No. 1 to the agreement between the City of Columbia and Job Point for the purchase of employment services.

Discussion

In2Action has terminated an agreement with the City of Columbia for the purchase of employment services for persons re-entering the community from incarceration. Additionally, the City of Columbia has opted not to renew an agreement with the Youth Empowerment Zone for employment services for low-income, young adults with barriers to employment. Service to these populations will shift to Job Point, which is currently contracted by the City of Columbia for employment services for low-income residents with barriers to employment.

The amendment will increase the total allowable compensation for program services under the agreement with Job Point from \$61,000.00 to \$89,936.00 to purchase three additional employment services: job placement, career exploration, and personal development.
