AN ORDINANCE

amending Chapter 2 of the City Code as it relates to the name, purpose, and objectives of the Substance Abuse Advisory Commission; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

DIVISION 10. SUBSTANCE <u>USE PREVENTION</u> <u>ABUSE</u> ADVISORY COMMISSION

Sec. 2-316. Establishment of commission; objectives.

The substance <u>use prevention</u> abuse advisory commission of the City of Columbia is hereby established, and shall have the following purposes and objectives:

- (1) To advise the city council in matters pertaining to substance <u>use abuse</u>.
- (2) To make recommendations intended to <u>reduce and</u> prevent- and eliminate the <u>abuse misuse of potentially harmful</u> of alcohol and other controlled substances.
- (3) To promote the coordination of programs directed towards the youth of the community intended to reduce and prevent the use of potentially harmful substances and eliminate alcohol and substance abuse.
- (4) To promote policies of inter-governmental cooperation in strengthening existing alcohol and <u>substance use disorder-drug abuse-programs</u>.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
