Re: Authorizing Software License Agreement with CUES, Inc. for CUES GraniteNet Software and CUES GraniteNet Software Support.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the City Manager to execute a software license agreement with CUES, Inc. for CUES GraniteNet Software and CUES GraniteNet Software Support.

Discussion

For more than 25 years, the City has relied on CUES as a trusted supplier of equipment and software for Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) inspection of stormwater and sewer systems. The CUES software is critical for multiple functions: inspecting pipes for defects and deterioration, assessing newly installed pipes for acceptance, locating underground pipes, and managing data in a database format. This database enables maintenance personnel and engineers to identify future projects, address maintenance needs, and support budgetary planning for both Sewer and Storm Water Utilities.

To ensure the software remains current and supported, the agreement includes an initial one-year term with the option to renew for four (4) additional one-year periods. The agreement includes ongoing updates and technical support. The agreement includes maintenance for five (5) GraniteNet Office Licenses and two (2) GraniteNet Inspection Licenses. The FY2026 cost for this service is \$6,620.00.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The first year term cost estimate for this project is \$6,620.00.

Long-Term Impact: Yearly renewal cost may include reasonable price increases.
