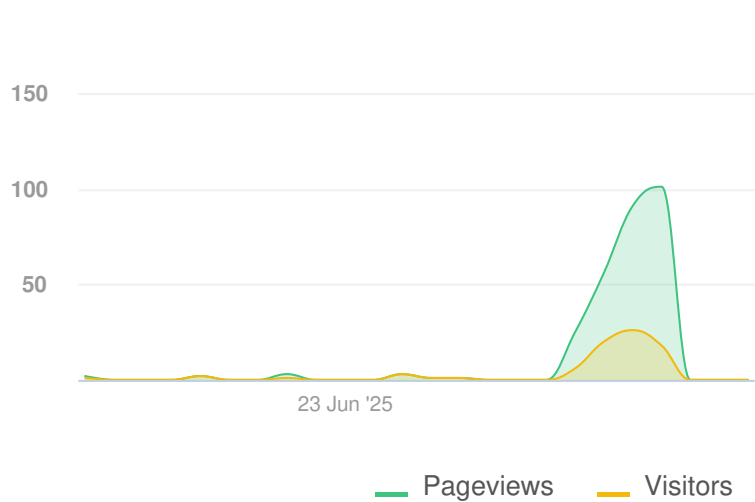

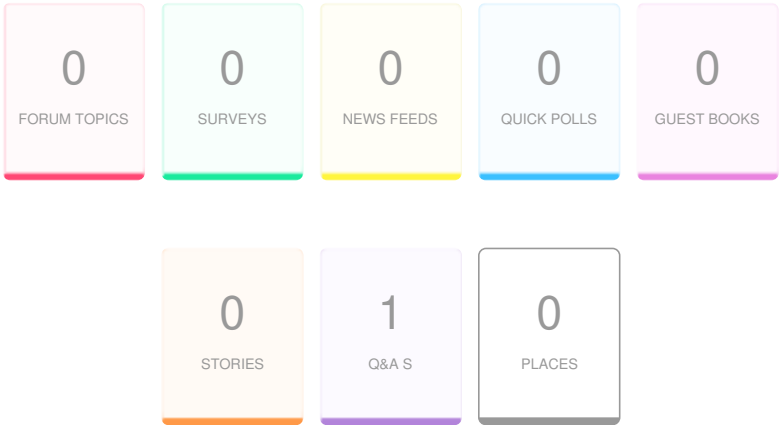

30 June 25	brandtlc	<p>Excited about the necessary renovation and the need to complete the project this summer before the start of the HS tennis season.</p> <p>The Bethel Park Tennis Courts have deteriorated to a dangerous degree due to prolonged neglect and a lack of prioritization. They now pose a serious safety hazard to the community. Despite repeated warnings over several years from USTA officials, local coaches, and members of the tennis community, neither the city nor the public school system has taken meaningful action to address these concerns. Most recently, a USTA official issued a stark warning: "Please use caution if you choose to play at Bethel and contact the city immediately if you get injured. I evaluated the courts in person recently and can only recommend courts one and three in good conscience." The urgency is especially critical now, as these courts are designated for Rockbridge High School's girls' tennis team, whose season begins with the start of the school year. If repairs are delayed beyond this summer, student-athletes—and their visiting competitors—will be forced to play on hazardous surfaces. This not only exposes the city and school system to serious legal liability, but more importantly, it puts our children at risk of entirely preventable injuries. I urge the city to act immediately. This is a matter of public safety, accountability, and basic respect for the well-being of our youth—the most valuable members of our community.</p>
