Re: REPORT – Case #16-45: Mayor's Task Force on Pedestrian Safety Interim Report

Executive Summary

This is an interim report from the Mayor's Task Force on Pedestrian Safety summarizing their work activities since they began their meetings in June, 2015. The Task Force is scheduled to complete their work and prepare a final report by April, 2016.

Discussion

The Mayor's Task Force on Pedestrian Safety has fifteen appointed members, and is co-chaired by City Council members Clyde Ruffin and Ian Thomas. Beginning with their initial meeting on June 30, 2015, the Task Force has since held seven meetings. During the months November-January, three subcommittees are meeting during a portion of the regularly scheduled Task Force meeting time to work more specifically on their focus issue, with those three issues being engineering, education, and enforcement. After the completion of the subcommittee meetings, the Task Force will meet in February and March prior to sending a final Council report by April, 2016.
