Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Ending the HIV Epidemic Contract for the period of November 1, 2020 through July 31, 2021. Amending the FY 2021 Annual Budget by adding a position to the Department of Public Health and Human Services. The contract amount shall not exceed \$125,293. Appropriating funds.

Discussion

Grant funding provided through this project will support the development and implementation of programs tailored to ending the Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV) epidemic in Missouri. PHHS will provide comprehensive HIV prevention services (which may also include Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) and Viral Hepatitis (VH) prevention and testing services) to 33 north-central Missouri counties. Also, funding from this grant is used to fund a new Health Educator position. We are requesting an amendment to the FY 2021 Annual Budget to add this position to the Department of Public Health and Human Services.
