Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign a Memorandum of Understanding between the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services and the City of Columbia.

Discussion

Under this Memorandum of Understanding the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services (MDHSS) will transfer nasal naloxone to Public Health and Human Services for distribution to local first responder agencies who have been trained by MDHSS. This agreement will remain in effect until September 30, 2021.
