It was great to meet you and hear more about the West Broadway project yesterday. I wanted to send an email with our concerns and possible solutions for consideration.

We are at the house at 1312 W Broadway and the slope of our driveway would be drastically impacted by adding a sidewalk. We would love if the city would consider widening the driveway, therefore distributing the slope over a longer distance, so we won't have this safety concern. I'm worried about being able to safely turn in the driveway, and in the winter, a steep slope worries me since I have some physical impairments and am fall-prone.

I'd also love if the city would consider a three-foot sidewalk instead. We don't get a ton of foot traffic across the street, so I think a three-foot sidewalk could be good enough. But y'all are the experts on that kind of thing.
