I. CALL TO ORDER

The City Council met on March 13, 2025 at approximately 5:04 p.m. in the Council Chamber of City Hall, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri.

Council Member Nick Foster, Council Member Don Waterman, Council Member Betsy Peters, Mayor Barbara Buffaloe, Council Member Valerie Carroll, and Council Member Jacque Sample were present. Council Member Lisa Meyer was absent.

- Individually identifiable personnel records, performance ratings or records pertaining to employees or applicants for employment pursuant to Section 610.021(13) RSMo.
